

Minutes of the Parents' Progress Meeting Monday 7th December 2015



Behaviour for Learning

Students have told us that they wish to see “greater punishment”. We have started a staff working party to look at the current policy.

Parents told us:

- they see a disappointing lack of rewards options, and a voucher scheme was suggested.
- how do students know how many points they have?
- the purple star pin badges are poor quality and often fall off.
- it appears that the higher ability students are given less rewards in the mixed ability classes.
- there is a lack of consistency in the issue of ‘consequences’. Some they feel are issued inappropriately. The Behaviour system needs to be seen as fair. Concerns were raised that new staff and especially supply teachers were inconsistently applying the policy.
- that the current policy with differing levels of Rewards and Consequences were confusing.
- they would like to see an online system where they could see details
- they would like to receive letters sent home

Marking
